among a mysterious family in a mountain cabin paul and nora united by an attraction that contains elements of repulsion find the keys to their fate mihail sebastian 1907 1945 was born in southeastern romania and worked in bucharest as a lawyer journalist novelist and playwright until anti semitic legislation forced him to abandon his public career his long lost diary journal 1935 1944 the fascist years was published in seven countries between 1996 and 2007 launching an international revival of his work sebastian s novels and plays are available in translation throughout europe and also have been published in chinese hindi bengali and hebrew

## Coming from an Off-Key Time 2014
