uncorrected errors remaining in the equipment upon completion of the maintenance task the majority of these errors reflected either a failure to use specifications or failure to use them correctly by contrast only 22 of the mechanics performing activities not requiring special tools or specifications left serious uncorrected errors in their work for tasks allowing final checkout to verify successful completion of the maintenance task 66 of the mechanics either failed to perform the checkout or did so incorrectly maintenance activities exhibiting a high probability of mechanic errors are identified for unit supervisor and trainer use in setting priorities for work assignments requiring closer supervision and checking on the spot correction provide the feedback necessary to develop maintenance proficiency through job experience
